Club Welfare Policy

Disciplinary Policy

If the behaviour of any young player within the Mini/Junior section (aged under 18 years of age), contravenes the players code of conduct while representing the Club, disciplinary action will be taken.

This includes behaviour: -

- on the club's premises
- before and after designated times of training/games
- on and off the field
- home or away games
- damage to club property

The procedure to be adopted will be as follows: -

The alleged incident should be reported to the Club Welfare Officer, who will notify a designated person on the Management Committee

The young player will be notified to attend a meeting with a parent or guardian, a representative of the appropriate Mini or Junior section, a representative from the Management Committee, the Club Welfare Officer and the team coach if appropriate.

The young player can be suspended from the club if deemed necessary, while the investigation takes place

Witnesses will be called upon if necessary

When a conclusion has been made the young player and the parent or guardian will be notified to attend a meeting to be informed of the outcome

All meetings will be minuted and an incident form will be completed

The Club will revoke membership of any member if deemed necessary.
