

PRUFC M&J Fundraising Policy

Mini and junior fundraising works like this:

All age groups get 1 free hall hire per season, including the under 12's, any more are charged at the normal members hire charge of £100.00 for next season, not including table coverings if required.

Both the under 12,s and the under 17's are the nominated priority fund raising teams for all seasons.

On Presidents day, at the end of the season, under 11's cook the BBQ (next years under 12's) to 'kick start' their fund, they are also responsible for organising the car parking and selling programmes, they can keep the income from programme sales, they cannot do a raffle, as the ladies have priority on this day, all food is supplied by the club, with profits being split 50/50, with a minimum of £100.00 guaranteed.

On mini festival day, the under 12's do the BBQ, the burgers and sausages and rolls are supplied by the club, with all profits to the club, the under 12,s are paid £50.00 for doing this. If they wish to sell any other stuff, such as bacon rolls, soup sweets etc, that is self funded and they keep the profits. Any other squads that wish to fund raise on this day, must agree it with the under 12,s.

On Sundays, when the minis are at home playing, the under 12's can cook and sell bacon rolls, sweets, and do raffles exclusively, when the juniors are at home playing, the under 17's have the same rights. Where both sides are training it is done by agreement on an alternating basis.

If on any of the above, in any particular season, one of these age groups elects not to do it, it reverts to the age group below for the whole season, if on any particular day, i.e.; presidents, mini festival, or Sundays, an age group cannot do it on that day only, it alternates between the 12's and 17's. Any other age groups that wish to fund raise on Sundays, must agree it with 12's or 17's.

In addition, 12's and 17's can fund raise within the club on Saturdays, by agreement with the committee, as long as it does not clash with any senior fund raising on that day.

At no time can any age group sell any form of liquid refreshment as part of their fund raising efforts.

All of this has been agreed by the management committee.
