Club Welfare Policy

Tours

Any team that goes on tour does so as a representative of Peterborough Rugby Club. Accordingly, the approval of the Club Management Committee is required. If a tour takes place without such approval, the Club's insurance policies do not apply. If a tour takes place after the Management Committee has withheld approval, the players shall no longer be members of the Club.

All requests for tours must be accompanied by a detailed written proposal and budget outlining how costs are to be met by personal contributions and fund raising. The Club will not underwrite any shortfall incurred by a tour.

All players under 18 years of age require written parent or guardian consent to tour. Written notification is required of any special medical or dietary requirements. A supply of such items with clear instructions must, where appropriate, be given to the tour organiser.

All tours will be expected to comply with RFU/RFUW rules as follows:

Teams wishing to tour outside the UK and Ireland require RFU approval in writing

Travel insurance cover must be arranged for all participants when travelling overseas.

Mini and Junior XV playing cover does not extend to competitive games played outside the Laws of the Game as outlined in the Continuum.

All tour organisers will be supplied with a copy of the RFU Tour Guidelines, which they are expected to follow.
